






Systems thinking suggests ...






... it makes sense to tackle the energy transition at municipal level

-  Local interest and involvement fosters tailor-made solutions


ERDF Operational Programme South – 2014-2020

-  Municipalities as launching customer




Logic was right, but municipalities not ready
